CABERNET SAUVIGNON

The Cabernet Sauvignon has aromas of cherry, prune, blackberry, with characteristics of earthiness, dried herbs, and bittersweet chocolate. It is medium to full body and was aged 12 months in French oak, it has a long elegant finish.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

A deep red with a full body, this wine is characterized by a rich, intense blackberry and cherry aroma, alongside notes of chocolate and refined oak. An 18-month aging process in new French oak barrels adds depth and complexity with a long smooth finish.

HAR EITAN

Har Eitan Blend 2012 is the result of meticulous and unique winemaking. Each variety was fermented in separate barrels for 12 months, and after blending, the wine was transferred to French oak barrels to age for an additional 12 months.

MERLOT

The Merlot has aromas of ripe cherry, prunes, with a hint of cocoa, refined oak, and fresh herbs. It is medium in body and was aged 12 months in French oak, it has a long elegant finish.

MERLOT

The color of the wine is a deep dark red, this wine has full body and rich, intense aroma of ripened black and red berries with caramel and spiced oak notes. An 18-month aging process in new French oak barrels adds depth and complexity, with a long, graceful finish.

SIRYON ROSÉ

After gentle pressing of the grape clusters and a short soak in the skins, the grapes fermented at a low temperature to preserve the aromas and fruit flavors. Wine varietals 80% Petite Verdot 20% Merlot. The wine is peach in color, with citrus aromas and candy, clean flavors and refreshing acidity.

AYALON

The source of the grapes for this unique blend is in the vineyards planted in the Ayalon Valley, where they were manually harvested. Wine character; dominant fruit, medium body, long and elegant finish. The wine aged for 12 months in French oak barrels.

SHIRAZ

The grapes selected for this Shiraz were harvested in a meticulous and selective harvest from the "dolev" vineyard, in the Samaritan hills area, at a height of 700 meters above sea level. The wine is full bodied, rich in color, a deep and intense red, with aromas of raspberries, plums and blueberries, combined with roasted oak and vanilla notes.

SIRYON CHARDONNAY

Siryon Chardonnay was produced from grapes carefully hand picked from quality vineyards in the mountains of Jerusalem. It is rich wine with a clear golden color combining fruity aromas of citrus, pineapple and tropical fruits in exquisite balance with a soft buttery wood touch.
